## Sports in Schools Program 2020

Dear Parents,

The Sport in Schools program will commence in Term 3 on Thursday, 23rd July, for all K-2 students. A team of professional PE instructors will implement weekly Fundamental Movement Skills PDHPE lessons at our school in Term 3 and a Gymnastics and Social Skills Program throughout Term 4.

Sport in Schools is an innovative program designed as a direct response to a recent decline in physical awareness amongst primary school aged students. Emphasis is placed on all children being actively involved in sporting activities in an engaging environment. During each weekly session, enjoyable and engaging challenges will be implemented to enhance the development of PE and social skills required in modified and traditional sports. Students will use a wide range of safe sporting equipment in a developmentally appropriate way. Sport in Schools are following safety operations protocols in line with the AHPPS, NSW Health and the Department of Education guidelines.

K-2 students will participate in a 40 minute lesson each week. Sports uniform should be worn each Thursday.

The cost of the Term 3 and 4 program is \$90.00. This may be paid in two payments of \$45, with the first due by Tuesday, 21st July and the second payment due by Tuesday, 22nd September. The last session will take place on Tuesday, 15th December as part of the K-2 Party Day. Sport in Schools will coordinate tabloid activities at this event.

Please forward the permission slip to your child's class teacher by **Tuesday**, **21st July**. Students **will not** be able to participate in the program without a permission note.
