2020 Annual Swimming Carnival

Our Annual Swimming Carnival will be held on **Tuesday**, **18th February 2020 at Riverstone Pool**, **Garfield Road**, **Riverstone**.

The carnival will commence at 9:30am and conclude at 2:10pm. Travel will be by bus which will depart school at 9:00am and return to school by 2:45pm. The cost will be **\$12.00** per child (includes bus fare and pool entry).

All children will be able to participate in events, with 50m races in freestyle, breaststroke, backstroke and butterfly for competent swimmers. There will be no novelty events this year for non-swimmers. Everyone is encouraged to attend and participate as it is always a lot of fun.

Parents, family members and friends are most welcome to attend. An entry fee of **\$2.80** per adult is charged. Anyone who wishes to help with the running of the carnival would be greatly appreciated and should indicate on the note over the page.

Children may wear their house colours and need to ensure they are sun safe by wearing a broad-brimmed hat, t-shirt / rash vest and bringing sunscreen to apply during the day. Please talk to your children about the importance of applying sunscreen regularly throughout the day.

Children will also need to bring a towel, recess, lunch and drinks. Canteen facilities will be available on the day if necessary. Please ensure your child comes prepared for either the carnival or a school day, in the unlikely event that the carnival is cancelled.

On the morning of the carnival, children will be issued with a coloured wristband. The wristband is waterproof and must be worn at all times whilst at the carnival. The coloured wristband is to help teachers and supervisors identify weak and strong swimmers.

Please fill in a separate permission note for each child and fill in all details. Please be aware you must nominate which events your child will enter. No students will be added to the events on the day.

Students must be able to swim 50m unassisted to enter any race.

All events will be held as timed finals and qualifiers will be selected according to times after the heats in each event.
